WELCOME BONDSVILLE MILL PARK TUESDAY, JUNE 9, 2015

The grand opening for our newest park will take place on June 9, 2015 at 4:00pm. Located at 1647 Bondsville Rd., Bondsville Mill Park is a passive historical and nature park comprising 47 acres of natural woodland and Beaver Creek frontage, with interesting views of the original historic mill buildings and the mill race. The park offers a mile of constructed hiking trails with a compacted gravel loop around the mill buildings and along the Beaver Creek, a nature trail up to the water tower and a loop to the north of the property through old spruce, maple and oak forest. At the entrance to the Park is a war memorial erected in honor of mill employees who served, and those who died, during the Second World War. Visit www.ebrandywine.org for more info.
